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Ronnie Seagren's *Seventh Daughter* to be published by Flying Pen Press

Author's first novel is high adventure in the Peruvian Andes of 1937

DENVER — Flying Pen Press is proud to announce the publication of *Seventh Daughter*, scheduled for April 24, 2008.

Set primarily in the Peru of 1937, *Seventh Daughter* is an exciting, character-driven Indiana Jones-style adventure fantasy. The seventh daughter of a seventh daughter, born under the shadow of a solar eclipse, Gil Orlov mysteriously lacks her birthright of power. Unknown to Gil, a twin sister was born just as totality ended. Gil must find her power to prevent her great-grandmother's Vision of the world in flames, reduced to a lifeless cinder.

Gil and her sisters travel to Peru to the hidden ruins of a hidden shrine called Killichaka — “Bridge to the Moon.” There, in the shadow of the solar eclipse of 1937, Gil hopes to regain her power to defeat the Vision. But her twin sister Miriam has other plans, as does an evil entity that calls itself Supay, the Peruvian name for the devil. Miriam and Supay will do anything to usurp Gil's legacy and ensnare her in their own dark designs.

Seventh Daughter races to its climax high in the Peruvian Andes, exploring the risk involved in letting go of what we value most to attain a higher goal. Security, personal freedom, hatred, even life itself — each character is challenged to risk the choice and face the consequences.

Ronnie Seagren began writing in high school as one of many creative pursuits. She is also a painter and avid nature and landscape photographer. She lives with her husband Frank in Denver, Colorado; they have three sons and three granddaughters. They enjoy singing together in their church choir and a '50s-'60s music group called the Lowdowns.

While *Seventh Daughter* is Seagren's first novel, she has previously published short fiction in two anthologies.
