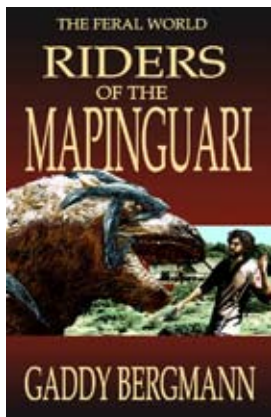


**From the desk of the Publisher, David A. Rozansky

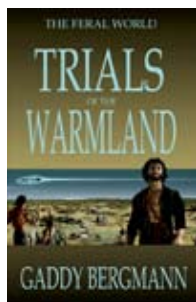
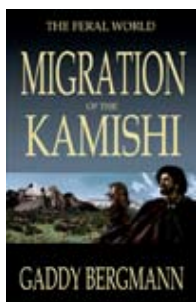
