***Riders of the Mapinguari* published by Flying Pen Press** Exciting Conclusion to Gaddy Bergmann's *Feral World* Trilogy

DENVER — Flying Pen Press announced the publication today of *Riders of the Mapinguari* by Gaddy Bergmann.

The final book in the *Feral World* trilogy, *Riders of the Mapinguari* concludes the post-apocalyptic odyssey begun in *The Migration of the Kamishi* (ISBN 978-0-9795889-1-4, trade paperback, \$16.95) and continued in *Trials of the Warmland* (ISBN 978-0-9795889-4-5, trade paperback, \$16.95). Set 3,000 years in the future, humanity has barely survived a near-extinction-level event – the collision of a major asteroid with Earth in the middle of the Twenty-First Century – and is now living in small tribes scattered across the continent. Blake has led the remnants of the massacred Kamishi through unexpected danger and enemies to reach the Warmland, where he and Lana have finally settled peacefully.

Their peace is shattered when the Warmland is attacked by an enemy quite unlike any they have ever faced before: the Terran army. Poised to conquer the Warmland, the Terrans not only greatly outnumber the natives, but they also have hundreds of mapinguari – giant beasts that can overpower anyone who would oppose them. Blake and his people must face them, though, if they hope to save not only themselves, but the entire Warmland.

Gaddy Bergmann was born in Petah-Tikva, Israel and moved when he was four to Denver, Colorado, where he still resides. Gaddy has a bachelor's degree in Environmental, Population, and Organismic Biology from the University of Colorado at Boulder, and a master's degree in Zoology from the University of South Florida in Tampa. Gaddy has done research in ecology and microbiology as well as teaching math, science, and composition. An admirer of animals and wildlife since childhood, he was inspired to write The Feral World books by the beauty of the natural wonders he saw all around him.
